

FIRST RESPONSE BROADCASTER STATION MANAGER APPROVAL

First Response Broadcaster Identification Cards are not intended for use by news personnel. The First Response Broadcaster program will help key engineering personnel to pass through police lines to access broadcast transmitters that keep stations "on the air" in order to continue to broadcast emergency information to the public.

If a person who is issued a First Response Broadcaster Identification Card leaves employment of your station, then the Station Manager is to collect the ID card and ensure its return to the IBA.

The First Response Broadcasters cards do have an annual expiration date and will be issued each year by the IBA upon Station Manager approval.
