Description of the Programs

SITE ASSESSMENT

Walkthrough of your broadcast facility to provide management with suggestions on **how to strengthen security measures as a preventative step**. The goal of the assessment is to help provide employees and station visitors with the safest environment possible.

ASR OR ACTIVE SHOOTER RESPONSE

Educate and empower employees on how to prepare and respond to an active shooter incident, by utilizing the "Run. Hide. Fight." method. The program can prepare employees on the proper methods of response in case of emergency.
