

FIRST RESPONSE BROADCASTER IDENTIFY CARD: APPROVAL FROM STATION MANAGER

The IBA provides a First Response Broadcaster identify card to engineering personnel, with approval from the station manager. Identification Cards are not to be used by newsgathering personnel. The purpose of the identity card is to help broadcast engineers pass through law enforcement lines to access broadcast transmitters in the event of an emergency, to maintain the vital link of the broadcast station to the public.

If a person who is issued an ID card leaves the employ of the station, the Station Manager or designee is asked to collect the ID card and return to the IBA at the address on the back of the card. By signing below, the Station Manager accepts responsibility for proper use of the First Response Broadcaster identity card.
